



Sports Premium Report

For the academic year 2016-17

This year Skidby School has used the majority of the Sports Premium Grant (SPG) to enhance the teaching and learning of Physical Education and provide additional after school sports experiences. A small amount has been used to support additional physical activity and Sports engagement.

The Premium provided three after school sessions open to all children.	To enable as many children who wished to learn new sports, these included Gymnastics, Basketball, Dodgeball, Tennis	Many children were exposed to new sports some went on to take up additional sports outside the school day. Children enjoy the sports activities and have a good relationship with the coaches which enable additional skills to be undertaken.
Chance to Shine for all- a cricket based course provided by Yorkshire County Cricket Team was available for classes 1 and 2 for 7 weeks for 90 minutes each week.	To learn all about cricket and to learn skills of using a small ball for throwing, catching and striking skills	All children who experience chance to Shine had better skills at the end of the course; they met with a cricket professional and learnt about Cricket.
Additional sports equipment was purchased using the SPG for Play and lunchtimes	Children could play and create their own games and activities.	Independent learning as well as social skills improved with children making rules for games and activities

The SPG was used to pay for the annual playground maintenance inspection	To ensure all apparatus that is fixed standing was safe and ready to use	Children were able to play on all the schools outside apparatus knowing that it was safe and ready for use.
The SPG was used to install a safe landing zone for the traversing wall built in the previous report	To ensure that children had a safe zone to land in if they fell off the wall	More children feel confident to use the wall knowing a safe landing is now possible.

The SPG was also used to:

- White line the field in preparation for the annual sports day.
- White line some areas of the field for mini and 5 aside football (autumn term)
- One additional grass cut to enable sports day to be effective after lots of rain and additional growth out of sequence for our grass cutting programme.
