<p style="text-align: center;">Science</p> <p>We will be studying the topic of animals including humans during the Autumn term.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Art and Design</p> <p>We will be learning about texture and form. The children will have the opportunity to develop their understanding and skills of creating ceramic flower designs with clay as part of our study of the craft maker, Paul Cummings.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Computing</p> <p>We will be learning about Data handling, knowing how to interpret and present data through computing.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Design and Technology</p> <p>We will be developing the children’s understanding of textiles where they will have to use and join materials, using appropriate tools to create a Christmas decoration in relation to our study of the designer Cath Kidston.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Maths</p> <p>We will be focusing on place value and addition & subtraction in Autumn 1 followed by shape and money in Autumn 2.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Reading</p> <p>Children will develop their reading skills reading a range of texts and furthering their understanding with a variety of follow up activities.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Music</p> <p>We will be studying African call and response music in Autumn 1 followed by orchestral instruments in Autumn 2.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">PE</p> <p>P.E. for Autumn 1 will be Hull FC Gymnastics on a Tuesday which will not have a club available.</p> <p>P.E for Autumn 2 will be Fencing with First Step Sports on a Wednesday where a multisport after-school club will be available.</p>	
<p style="text-align: center;">RE</p> <p>In Autumn 1. we will be focusing around the question of ‘What do Christians believe God is like?’ as part of our Understanding Christianity topic with a link to Christianity, Islam and Humanism.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">History</p> <p>We will learn about Heroes and Heroines? with a particular focus on Florence Nightingale & Mary Seacole including who they were; roles and responsibilities and comparing these to the modern day and fictional hero.</p>

Your child will develop their writing skills including: Planning, drafting, evaluating, editing and proof-reading their writing and applying vocabulary, grammar and punctuation through the forms of character descriptions, posters, original writing, diary entry and more.</p>
