

## Class 4 Curriculum Newsletter

### Spring Term 2023

Welcome back to everyone. This term our topic will be 'Ancient Egypt' and we will cover many areas of the curriculum throughout this. Please see below an overview of what we will be studying during this time.

<b>Art and Design</b> The children will be learning about technical drawing and sculpture. They will be looking at the works of Adrian Smith.	<b>Science</b> The children will be studying light and electricity	<b>Computing</b> The children will be learning about keeping safe online and ways to protect themselves.
<b>Design and Technology</b> The children will be developing their understanding of structures and mechanisms. Thinking about how the Egyptians built pyramids and comparing to resources available today.	<b>History</b> The children will learn about ancient Egypt. They will focus specifically on two significant individuals (Tutankhamun and Howard Carter) and learn about how they have impacted the world today.	
<b>MFL</b> The children will be focusing on language used when visiting a French town.	<b>Music</b> The children will be learning about rhythms, dynamics, pitch and tempo.	<b>PE</b> PE will be on a Tuesday during the first half term and the focus will be gymnastics. After Easter it will be archery on a Wednesday
<b>RE</b> Children will explore the question-What does it mean to be a Muslim?	<b>Maths</b> Children will continue learning about fractions, decimals and percentages. As well as measurement including perimeter, area and volume.	
<b>Writing</b> The children will be studying the text, The Red Pyramid by Rick Riordan. They will be writing to inform and to entertain by writing poems, narratives and newspaper articles		<b>Reading</b> They will develop their reading skills studying a simplified version of 'A Midsummer Night's Dream. They will be learning about the vocabulary used how to use evidence questions effectively to support their answers.
