

Class 4 Curriculum Newsletter

Autumn Term 2022

Welcome back to everyone. This term our topic will be WWII and we will cover many areas of the curriculum throughout this. Please see below an overview of what we will be studying during this time.

Science The children will be studying animals including humans for the first half term with a focus on the changes human beings experience as they develop to old age. Then living things and their habitats.	Art and Design The children will be learning about John Constable and taking inspiration from his paintings to create their own poppy landscapes.	Computing The children will be learning about spreadsheets including formatting data and using formulas.
Design and Technology The children will be developing their sewing skills to create a Christmas decoration inspired by Coco Chanel.	Geography The children will be learning about the geographical similarities and differences between Hull, Dunkirk and Hawaii.	History The children will learn about WWII looking at the impact the war had worldwide.
MFL The children will be learning how to communicate in French about our homes and holidays.	Music The children will be learning about songs from WWII and films.	PSHE The children will be learning about families and relations as well as health and wellbeing.
RE Children will explore the question 'What does it mean if God is Holy and Loving?'	Maths Children will be learning place value and developing their understanding of the value of digits, ordering and comparing numbers as well as understanding how to round them. Children will also develop their understanding of the 4 operations (including +/-/x/÷), fractions and decimals.	
Writing The children will be learning about genres of writing that informs and persuades people. They will learn how to write using criteria such as expanded noun phrases and relative clauses. They will then have the opportunity to complete extended writing including reports, recounts, diaries, biographies and letters.		Reading The children will be studying Letters from the Lighthouse by Emma Carrol. They will focus on areas including vocabulary, prediction and retrieval this term.
