This term our topic will be All in the Past with a focus on Neil Armstrong. We will cover many areas of the curriculum throughout this. Please see below an overview of what we will be studying over the Summer term.

<p>Maths</p> <p>We will be focusing fractions and time in Summer 1. In Summer 2, we will be revisiting the four operations + - x ÷ with a focus on problem solving as well as statistics and geometry.</p>		<p>Design and Technology</p> <p>We will be developing the children’s understanding of Food Technology where they will have to design and explain their ideas; choose appropriate ingredients and equipment explaining their choice as well as evaluating their final product.</p>	
<p>Geography</p> <p>The children will be learning to develop their skills and fieldwork by using a range of maps, atlases, globes and photos to compare and contrast features of the local community as well as undertaking simple fieldwork within school locality.</p>		<p>Science</p> <p>We will be studying the topic of plants as well as living things and their habitats during the Summer term.</p>	<p>Reading</p> <p>Children will develop their reading skills reading a range of texts and furthering their understanding with a variety of follow up activities.</p>
<p>Music</p> <p>We will be studying pitch and tempo in Summer 1 and Vocal and body sounds in Summer 2.</p>	<p>Computing</p> <p>We will learn how to programme animations using Scratch Junior.</p>	<p>PE</p> <p>P.E. for Summer 1 will be First Step Sports on a Wednesday which will have a club available. P.E for Summer 2 will be Hull FC on a Thursday which will have a club available.</p>	
<p>RE</p> <p>In Summer 1, we will be learning the topic ‘Wonderful World’ with a link to Humanism. In Summer 2 we will study the topic ‘Why is the World Special?’ from Understanding Christianity.</p>		<p>History</p> <p>We will learn about the topic of Space with a key focus on Neil Armstrong. We will learn the significance his achievements have had on the world around us as well as how he showcased the schools vision and values.</p>	
<p>Writing</p> <p>We will be studying a range of stories including The Conquerors by David McKee and The Pirates Next Door by Jonny Duddle this Spring term. Your child will develop their writing skills including: Planning, drafting, evaluating, editing and proof-reading their writing and applying vocabulary, grammar and punctuation through the forms of recounts, instructional writing, persuasion and many more.</p>
