This term our topic will be the Mayan Civilisation with a focus on Hernan Cortes. We will cover many areas of the curriculum throughout this. Please see below an overview of what we will be studying over the coming weeks.

<p style="text-align: center;">Science</p> <p>The children will be studying plants in the first half term and sound in the second.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Computing</p> <p>The children will be learning about programming.</p>	
<p style="text-align: center;">Design and Technology</p> <p>The children will be developing their understanding of food technology which will include seasonality and food hygiene.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Geography</p> <p>The children will be studying skills and fieldwork, with a focus on the mapwork.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">History</p> <p>The children will be learning about the Mayans and the production of chocolate as well as studying Hernan Cortes.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">French</p> <p>The children will be focussing on vocabulary linked to transport and the circle of life.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Music</p> <p>The children will be listening to jazz and creating pieces using traditional instruments.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">PE</p> <p>PE will be on a Tuesday with Hull FC practising dance until half term, then a Wednesday with First Steps practising archery.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">RE</p> <p>Children will explore sacred places and then the concept of creation in Christianity.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Maths</p> <p>Year 3 will continue to study fractions and then money, time, shape and statistics. Year 4 will study decimals, money, time, shape, statistics and position and direction.</p>	
<p style="text-align: center;">Writing</p> <p>The children will be studying The Great Chocoplot by Chris Callaghan alongside Rain Player by David Wisniewski. Children will have the opportunity to write in a range of given forms including: narratives, persuasive texts and balanced arguments. They will also explore other non-fiction texts throughout, mixed with poetry.</p>		<p style="text-align: center;">Reading</p> <p>Children will develop their reading skills through our main book and also accompanying texts which will include non-fiction and poetry.</p>
