This term our topic will be the Mayan Civilisation with a focus on Hernan Cortes. We will cover many areas of the curriculum throughout this. Please see below an overview of what we will be studying over the coming weeks.

Science The children will be studying plants in the first half term and sound in the second.		Computing The children will be learning about programming.	
Design and Technology The children will be developing their understanding of food technology which will include seasonality and food hygiene.	Geography The children will be studying skills and fieldwork, with a focus on the mapwork.		History The children will be learning about the Mayans and the production of chocolate as well as studying Hernan Cortes.
French The children will be focussing on vocabulary linked to transport and the circle of life.	Music The children will be listening to jazz and creating pieces using traditional instruments. RE Children will explore sacred places and then the concept of creation in Christianity.	Maths Year 3 will continue to study fractions and then money, time, shape and statistics. Year 4 will study decimals, money, time, shape, statistics and position and direction.		
Writing The children will be studying The Great Chocoplot by Chris Callaghan alongside Rain Player by David Wisniewski. Children will have the opportunity to write in a range of given forms including: narratives, persuasive texts and balanced arguments. They will also explore other non-fiction texts throughout, mixed with poetry.		Reading Children will develop their reading skills through our main book and also accompanying texts which will include non- fiction and poetry.
