This term our topic will be Rome with a focus on Julius Caesar. We will cover many areas of the curriculum throughout this. Please see below an overview of what we will be studying over the coming weeks.

<p>Science The children will be studying states of matter for the first half term and forces and magnets in the second half term.</p>	<p>Art and Design The children will be learning about the architect Libon from Ancient Greek times and developing their technical drawing skills.</p>	<p>Computing The children will be learning about e-safety.</p>
<p>Geography The children will be studying human and physical features of geography.</p>	<p>History The children will be learning about the rule of Julius Caesar and life in Ancient Rome.</p>	
<p>French The children will be focussing on core vocabulary to describe French playground games and items in a French classroom.</p>	<p>Music The children will be creating compositions in response to animations and listening to pentatonic melodies and composition.</p>	<p>PE PE will be on a Wednesday with First Steps practising fencing until half term, then a Thursday with Hull FC doing athletics until Easter. Weather permitting, it will be outdoor PE.</p>
<p>RE Children will explore founders of faith and why Christians call the day Jesus died 'Good Friday'.</p>	<p>Maths Year 3 will study multiplication and division, length and perimeter, fractions and mass and capacity. Year 4 will study multiplication and division, length and perimeter, fractions and decimals.</p>	
<p>Writing The children will be studying Julius Zebra by Gary Northfield. Children will have the opportunity to write in a range of given forms including: diary entries, character descriptions and play scripts. They will also explore narrative writing in more detail and build up their skills to write their own 5-part narrative.</p>		<p>Reading Children will develop their reading skills through our main book and also accompanying texts which will include non-fiction and poetry.</p>
