Welcome back to everyone. This term our topic will be 'Leaders and their Legacy' and we will cover many areas of the curriculum throughout this. Please see below an overview of what we will be studying during this time.

<p>Art and Design</p> <p>The children will be learning about technical drawing with a focus on Libon and the Temple of Zeus.</p>	<p>Science</p> <p>The children will be studying properties of material and forces</p>	<p>Computing</p> <p>The children will be learning about keeping safe online and ways to protect themselves.</p>	
<p>Geography</p> <p>The children learn about key aspects of physical geography including climate zones, biomes and earthquakes.</p>	<p>History</p> <p>The children will learn about ancient Greece. They will focus specifically on Alexander the Great and learn about how they have impacted the world today.</p>		
<p>MFL</p> <p>The children will be focusing on language used when shopping.</p>	<p>Music</p> <p>The children will be learning about composition, notation and the Blues.</p>	<p>PSHE</p> <p>The children will be learning about safety including the changing body and citizenship.</p>	
<p>RE</p> <p>Children will explore the question-What are challenges? They will then explore what difference the resurrection makes to Christians.</p>	<p>Maths</p> <p>Y5- Multiplication, division, fractions, decimals, percentages, perimeter, area and statistics Y6-Ratio, algebra, decimals, fractions, decimals, percentages, area, perimeter, volume and statistics.</p>		<p>PE</p> <p>This term the children will be learning about gymnastics and archery.</p>
<p>Writing</p> <p>The children will be learning about genres of text that entertain and persuade. They will have the opportunity to complete extended writing including narratives (fantasy/mythical), formal letters, leaflets and adverts.</p>		<p>Reading</p> <p>They will develop their reading skills studying Percy Jackson and the Lightning Thief, by Rick Riordan, alongside other texts. They will be learning about how to make appropriate inferences using evidence effectively to support their answers.</p>
